We offer 16 college credits, at no cost to the Police Communication Operators who enroll at Rio Salado and complete the Phoenix Communications Bureau training program. Students are awarded college credits and a Certificate of Completion in Emergency Communications.

These credits can be applied toward a number of associate degrees including Organizational Management and the Associate of Arts.
